

A student computer centre has been established at the College of Horticulture under the ICAR Development Grant during the X plan in the year 1980. The centre aims to train all the student members computer literate. It also imparts training to students academic and ministerial staff on various aspects of IT related multimedia programs. This centre is a self supporting centre with an admission fee and monthly membership fee. training students provides high speed broad band internet connectivity. It also provides scanning, copying and printing facilities to the students and academic staff of the College. At present, there are more than 400 members in this computer centre.
